B4117 COVENTRY ROAD, SAPCOTE, IN THE DISTRICT OF BLABY) (IMPOSITION OF 50  
MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 5, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (The Act) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

1. To impose a 50 mph speed limit on various lengths of B4114 from Croft to its junction with A5, Broughton Road, Croft, B581 from Stoney Stanton to Broughton Astley, B4669 from B4114 to M69 and Sharnford Road, Sapcote from B4117 Coventry Road, Sapcote.
